## **Ambassadors' Requirements for Application**

- 1. Age Requirement: Freshman Senior in High School.
- 2. 4-H Member for at least two years.
- 3. Enroll in the Leadership Project
- 4. Complete the Ambassador Application
- 5. Complete the Interview Process

### **Requirements for Ambassadors**

- 1. Commitment to the Grant County 4-H Program.
- 2. Positive Attitude about 4-H and all other 4-H'ers.
- 3. Willingness to promote 4-H to the public.
- 4. Willingness to work as a team and respect each other's ideas.
- 5. Willingness to participate in Ambassador functions and leadership activities such as, but not limited to:
  - A. Introducing new families to the 4-H program at Project Enrollment Fair and be available to answer questions.
  - B. National 4-H Week promotion on the radio, delivering table tents to restaurants, taking posters to businesses, sponsoring the window display contest for the clubs, etc.
  - C. Organize and/or Narrate the Fashion Revue, Achievement Banquet, & 4-H Day.
  - D. Help organize the "Supporter Appreciation" activities in your club.
  - E. Organize, plan, and conduct Grant County Fair 4-H Promotional activity.
  - F. Participate in activities that the Ambassador group votes to participate in.
  - G. Do a community service activity every quarter of the year:

    Home Products, Health Fair, Spring Fling, Fall Fest, Library Story Hour
  - H. Represent the Grant County 4-H Program with a high degree of integrity and pride, whether at County or out of County events.
  - I. Submit a Record Book consisting of: Personal Page, Project Forms, & Permanent Record to continue being an Ambassador through the next year.
  - J. Presentations at Civic Groups.
  - K. Help promote 4-H information thru media, radio, table tents, web posting, etc. as requested.
  - L. Hold at least two (2) Fundraisers a year as Ambassadors

#### **Attendance Requirements:**

**Policy:** Attend ALL regular Ambassador bi-monthly meetings. Excused absences include school activity, sickness (absence from school the day of), or out of town with family. Extension staff must be notified prior to excused absence. **Two** un-excused absences results in dismissal from the Ambassador program.

#### Ambassadors are strongly encouraged to:

- 1. Attend Kansas Youth Leaders Forum (KYLF) at Rock Springs in November.
- 2. Attend SWKYLF in January in Dodge City.
- 3. Attend State Ambassador Training at Rock Springs in the Spring.
