County Fair Preparation

Lost Ear Tags-----

If your animal has lost an ear tag, you need to contact the Extension Office as soon as possible so a new one can be put in before Fair.

Pen Assignments-----

The livestock Pen Assignment Chart will be posted in the barns no later than Friday, July 14th by noon.

The Fair Board will be handing out wood chips on Monday, July 17th from 10:00 a.m., to 12 noon and 4:00 - 5:00 p.m., then on Tuesday, July 18th from 8:00 a.m. to noon. Envelopes with your tickets for your free wood chips will be available in the Rabbit/Poultry barn where the wood chips are handed out. That is your allotment for the Fair.

Please take your full allotment at that time.

If you need wood chips over the weekend you need to get in contact with the Civic Center staff. The Fair Board has donated the wood chips again this year. Take time out and give them a BIG THANK YOU!

Livestock Check In

Swine will be put in the pens, watered and etc. and they will be weighed last. All other animals will be weighed first. It will be a first come first served basis. Try and get your animals there as early as you can.

Round Robin is scheduled for Friday, morning July 21st at 9:30 a.m. with the exhibitor meeting starting at 9:00 a.m. A poster will be hung in the barns with the names of those qualifying.
