4-H Fair Participation Requirements

If you do not complete these by the deadlines, you may still enter in Open Classes at the Grant County Fair.

- Enroll in v2.4honline.com by 12/31/22
- Attend at least **six** 4-H Club Meetings (may count 2 excused absences)
- Attend at least two project meetings per project
- Add desired projects to v2.4honline.com account by 3/31/23
- Turn in all fair entry paperwork to Extension Office by 7/1/23
- For livestock projects, complete Youth Quality Care Assurance (YQCA) Certification by **7/1/23**
- Turn in 4-H Record Book by 9/29/23

Livestock Weigh-In/Tag-In

BEEF February 18, 9 am – 12 noon SMALL ANIMAL April 23, 2 pm – 6 pm or April 24, 5 pm – 7 pm

For youth planning on showing livestock at the county fair, livestock must be tagged-in and weighed on these dates. Market animals planning to be sold at the Premium Auction must make certain weight requirements for their respective species. Breeding livestock do not need weighed, but still are required to be tagged in. Breeding animals are not eligible for the Premium Auction at County Fair.
