LIVESTOCK EARTAGS

We are using the EID (Electronic Identification) ear tags. At all the

weigh-in's we will be using these ear tags as we have the past 2 or 3 years.

Windy Prairie Show Feeds and Show Cattle (Kevin Shapland) will pay for 1 ear tag per 4-H'er per specie this year. If you have more than one animal in a specie you will have to pay for those ear tags.

The cost of ear tags are as follows: Beef & Bucket Calf - \$3.50 Sheep, Swine, Goat - \$2.75

Country of Origin Paper Requirements
